Joint Plenary Symposium Congenital Heart Disease: Examining the Spectrum of Care from Birth to Adulthood (sponsored by SSCI and SSPR)

Speakers: Dianna Milewicz (UTHealth), Ali Zaidi (Mt. Sinai), and Martina Brueckner (Yale)
Congenital heart diseases refer to the range of structural defects that occur during the development of the heart. Recent investigations in the genetic and molecular causes of these defects have led to advances in the diagnosis and treatment of this condition. The focus of this plenary is to explore the genesis of congenital heart disease and to describe recent advances in clinical care.

SSCI Presidential Symposium

The Story of Cystic Fibrosis: Gene Discovery to Drug Development (sponsored by SSCI)

Speakers: J.P. Clancy (Cystic Fibrosis Foundation) and Raksha Jain (UTSW)

Cystic fibrosis is caused by a mutation of the cystic fibrosis transmembrane conductance regulator (CFTR) gene. The human genome project led to the discovery of the CFTR gene sequence which led to the development of drugs that modify the effects of the CFTR gene mutation. This symposium will cover the discovery of the sequence of the CFTR, the drug development that followed this discovery, and the clinical outcomes following CFTR modulator therapies.
