Immunology has recently gained attention for novel therapies and advancement in the treatment of immunological diseases for newborns, children, and adults. The focus of this plenary is to learn about updates in immunology across the lifespan from newborn screening of immunological diseases to updates and advancements in treatments for children and adults with a focus on congenital immunologic defects.

In this symposium, two department of medicine chairs in our region will detail the science through which they and their collaborators have changed patient care in the last several years and for the years ahead in the fields of cardiology and pulmonology, respectively.

Tinsley Harrison Scholar Awards. The SSCI is continuing this novel program, which we started last year for MD or MD/PhD investigators at the level of postdoctoral fellow, instructor, and assistant professor during the first 1-2 years of appointment. The purpose of these awards is to facilitate networking and career development among a community of young investigators as well as engagement with more senior leaders in SSCI who can serve as career sponsors and advisors. Airfare (economy), registration, and hotel expenses (up to \$1,500) will be reimbursed for the individuals chosen for these awards. Tinsley Harrison Scholars are expected to attend all required programming events in order to receive reimbursement for their travels.
